Over the last year there have been several applications for each callsign which should have been assigned, but were not. These two callsigns appear to be available for assignment based on FCC license data, but yet applications have been dismissed.

1) Why are these two callsigns not available for assignment?

2) What other callsigns are similarly unavailable for assignment even though they appear that they should be

available?

3) Will the FCC refund application fees for dismissed vanity applications that include N6ER, N1GI or other unavailable callsigns? Licensees have no way of knowing that these callsigns are not actually available for assignment.

Objections to the assignment of requested call signs will not be entertained at the FCC. However, this does not hamper any party from asserting such rights as it may have under private law in some other forum. Should it be determined by an appropriate forum that a station should not utilize a

particular call sign, the initial assignment of a call sign will not serve as a bar to the making of a different assignment.

Description: To Whom it May Concern

I am writing this message on behalf of numerous amateur radio operators who have paid a \$35.00 application fee for a particular call sign, to ultimately have their application dismissed by the FCC due to no fault of their own. The FCC maintains a list of call signs that are "unavailable for issuance" due to derogatory action taken upon that call sign by a previous operator or for various other reasons determined by the FCC. However, this internal FCC "unavailable" call sign list is not publicized in any fashion for the general public to peruse, which would (if available) provide applicants the necessary information to properly inform them of legitimately available call signs during the application process. I will provide an example for context purposes. One amateur radio call sign example is "N6ER." I happen to have knowledge that the FCC will not currently issue this call sign to applicants as the FCC considers it "unavailable" for issuance. However, unsuspecting applicants have no way of knowing this beforehand, and thus they ultimately pay the \$35.00 application fee not knowing that their application will be dismissed and they will have paid \$35.00 for an improper exchange of services. I offer the following solution to the FCC in this scenario.

- 1) Provide a list of "unavailable" call signs in the ULS system for applicants to review during the application process. This list would be independent of the already available sequential call sign system and vanity call sign information that is provided and published by the FCC. By doing so, and incorporating an easily available and obvious warning to applicants pertaining to these particular call signs, they the FCC would be relatively justified in keeping the application fees as the public was properly informed ahead of the application submission.
- 2) If the FCC wishes not to publicize its internal list of "unavailable" call signs, then any application fee paid for one of the FCC's "unavailable" calls signs should be immediately refunded to the applicant as no error can be attributed to the applicant. The call sign requested wasn't in an improper format. The call sign applicant was not competing with other applicants. The call sign applicant did not submit for a call sign that was of insufficient class, in a restricted region, or reserved, etc.
- 3) Furthermore, the FCC should provide refunds for all applicants to date that fall into the above scenario since the re-establishment of the amateur radio call sign application fee.

On May 30, 2023, you filed the above-referenced application to modify your license for Amateur Radio Service Station (b) (6) by changing the call sign to N6ER. On June 22, 2023, the application was dismissed on the grounds that the requested call sign was not available. In your petition, you state that there was only one other person in competition for N6ER and that their application was unpaid at the time of your dismissal. The Commission has designated the requested call sign as unavailable for assignment to any applicant. Consequently, we find that your application was properly dismissed.

You may request a refund of the dismissed application fee in cases where the application contains only call signs where you were unable to determine in advance that the call sign was unavailable for licensing.
